

Tassie Holiday Voucher

CONSUMER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- You must reside in South Australia, Queensland, or Western Australia.
- This ballot is for travellers to Tasmania. It is open to people 18 years or older, subject to the [Tasmanian Public Health Directions](#) and associated travel restrictions that apply to residents of individual states at the time of registering for the ballot.
- You can register for the ballot once only.
- Tassie Holiday Vouchers are strictly limited to one per person and are subject to eligibility.
- The Tassie Holiday Voucher is a single voucher with a total face value of \$300. The Tassie Holiday Voucher allows for \$200 to be put towards accommodation and \$100 towards tours and attractions.
- 10,000 x \$300 Tassie Holiday Vouchers will be available to a total value of \$3,000,000.
- To enter the ballot for a Tassie Holiday Voucher you must register online during the ballot registration period.
- Anyone who is unable to register online during this period can call (03) 7037 2222 between 9:30am and 6:00pm (AEDT), Monday to Friday.
- The ballot registration period starts on Friday, 29 October 2021 at 9:00am (AEDT) and ends on Tuesday 2 November 2021 at 5:00pm (AEDT).
- At the time of registration, applicants will be asked for, and must provide, their full name, phone number, driver's licence number

(or other recognised identification number), email address and home address.

- Registering for the ballot is not a guarantee, warranty, representation, or commitment of receiving a Tassie Holiday Voucher and Tourism Tasmania, its employees, agents and contractors make no guarantee, warranty, representation or commitment whatsoever that your registration or application for a Tassie Holiday Voucher will result in receipt or issue of a Tassie Holiday Voucher.
- Tassie Holiday Vouchers will be allocated via random selection of valid registrations.
- Successful Tassie Holiday Voucher recipients will be notified and receive their Tassie Holiday Voucher and unique code via email and SMS (if a mobile number was provided) on 3 November 2021.
- Tassie Holiday Vouchers can only be redeemed with participating Tourism Businesses listed on the marketplace portal.
- Tassie Holiday Vouchers must be redeemed between 3 November 2021 and 17 November 2021 for bookings in the eligible travel period between 4 November 2021 and 31 December 2021.
- Any bookings undertaken outside the travel period, booked after the redemption period specified above or booked outside of the marketplace portal cannot be claimed using the Tassie Holiday Voucher.
- There is no minimum spend for Tassie Holiday Vouchers. They can be partly redeemed but cannot exceed a total redemption value of \$300 that includes up to \$200 towards accommodation and \$100 towards tours and attractions.
- Tassie Holiday Voucher recipients can redeem their Tassie Holiday Voucher by:

- (i) visiting the marketplace portal to access the list of participating Tourism Businesses and their registered offers
 - (ii) selecting a product to book that the Tassie Holiday Voucher holder wishes to redeem their voucher against and following the booking instructions provided for that offer. The voucher discount will be immediately deducted from the price, leaving the voucher recipient with only the balance to pay (if applicable).

- Subject to being used within the stipulated travel period and availability of accommodation and/or tours and attractions, the Tassie Holiday Voucher can be used on any day of the week, including weekends.
 - Tassie Holiday Vouchers are non-transferrable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
 - Tassie Holiday Vouchers cannot be used to purchase gift cards
 - Tassie Holiday Vouchers cannot be used to pay for cancellations or fees incurred for cancelling or changing bookings.
 - Unsuccessful Tassie Holiday Voucher applicants will be notified via email on 3 November 2021.
 - The ballot draw is final – there is no opportunity for appeal.
 - During the eligible travel period, Tassie Holiday Voucher recipients are subject to, and must fully comply with, Public Health directions in relation to travel.
 - Successful recipients will be subject to the refund and cancellation policies of the Tourism business that they choose to redeem their voucher with.
